RETURN TO OPEN SESSION

All members certified returning to open session for discussion.

LHRC Member Application:

The LHRC conducted an applicant Interview of Will Childers for the Roanoke-Catawba LHRC and the Virginia Highlands LHRC. A motion was made by Lisa Dishner to approve the application and seconded by Natacha Liriano. The LHRC committee unanimously approved the application of Will Childers for an **“Other Position”** position as an LHRC member for the Roanoke- Catawba LHRC and the Virginia Highlands LHRC. The committee will make a recommendation to the SHRC to approve his membership application.

Wall Residences- Restriction Review #1:

The LHRC committee determined that the restriction review is **not** in compliance with regulatory code 12VAC35-115-50 and 12VAC35-115-100. The LHRC committee has further noted that this request dose not meet the definition for a medical restriction and has been determined to be a violation of the Individual’s rights, regulatory code 12VAC35-115-100 (A)(1)(a): Freedom to move within the service setting, its grounds and the community.

Wall Residences- Restriction Review #2 update (return review): The LHRC committee determined that this restriction review is NOT in compliance with the regulatory code 12VAC35-115-50 and 12VAC35-115-100. The LHRC committee requests additional information for review regarding this restriction request review and for provider to return for another LHRC update/review within the next 6 months.

Wall Residences Next Friend Review #3:

The LHRC committee determined that the Next Friend review is **NOT in compliance** with regulatory code 12VAC35-115-146, as the proposed friend chosen may not have the Individual’s best interest in mind, however, the committee notes that the Individual agrees with this next friend designation. The LHRC Committee has chosen to grant permission for temporary designation of the proposed next friend, until a new next friend is found/identified The LHRC requests that Provider return for a new Next Friend Review (quarterly), until a more appropriate next friend is identified for this provider.

Wall Residences- Restriction Review #4:

The LHRC committee determined that this restriction review is NOT in compliance with regulatory code 12VAC35-115-50 and 12VAC35-115-100. The LHRC committee requests additional information for the review regarding this restriction request and for the provider to return for another LHRC update/review within 6 months.
